

Callaghan Valley Backcountry Access 2011-2012

Whistler Olympic Park and Callaghan Country will operate separately for the 2011-2012 season. This year Whistler Olympic Park will allow backcountry skiers to use the groomed XC trails for backcountry access. Signage for backcountry users is being improved and overnight parking will be permitted in a designated lot near the main gate. A Whistler Olympic Park backcountry access ticket costs \$10. At Callaghan Country backcountry users must purchase a full price ski or snowshoe ticket.. Part of the Callaghan Country parking lot near Alexander Falls will be designated for overnight use.
