Thanks for taking the time to provide your comments to the EAO during the recent Garibaldi at Squamish Supplemental Application Environmental Assessment comment period.

We have enclosed a copy of Figure 3 of the Executive Summary which shows the major changes to this proposal since 2009. One of the reasons Garibaldi at Squamish deleted several proposed development areas was to reduce impacts on the mountain user groups. We also have increased the buffer zone between the ski areas and Garibaldi Provincial Park, as you have noted. We appreciate that your Club utilizes this area for climbing and hiking trips, among other activities on the proposed resort development site. We would welcome the opportunity to dialogue with you and/or your Club to talk about the proposed time frame for the potential build out of the project and to understand your concerns so we can explore cooperative ways we can work together.
