Destruction of forest ecosystems (streams, animal habitat, loss of trees & slow regrowth, land erosion)

Use of deactivated forestry roads - access & protection

Inadequate Environmental impact studies

Bio diversity of the land base - water quality, wilderness areas

Protection of riparian zones on streams, rivers & lakes

Changes to habitat affect temperature to streams, runoff of debris into waterway changes to stream/river channel and to debris jams. Increased deposits of sediment due to logging

Inadequate Environmental impact studies

Free to grow is a problem with bio diversity and wildlife habitat. It promotes monoculture forests with little to no habitat for wildlife

Access on private forestry lands

To much access being created - need access management plans

Trespass issues re: private land

Access thru forestry areas is being curtailed by various companies

Restricted areas & trail degradation

Lack of clarity on road access, especially clarity about road deactivation and clarity on procedures for ensuring public access

Land use agreements = success

Section 56 - not too difficult; Section 57 beyond difficult
Forest companies removing existing trails
Severe impact of forestry practices (clearcutting) on recreational trails & narrow buffer zones between the cuts and the trails
Quantify tourism & economic impacts
Cycling assoc - letter to gov't lobbying basically wrote back in support of logging in our areas; no response to tourism value
Impact on Apex Mt. Resort logging tourism economic base & thus impact on property values
Increased cooperation between non-commercial & commercial recreation
Clearcuts create more area for motorized recreationists & less for non-motorized - need balance
Increased conflicts with motorized/non-motorized users
Managing multiple user groups on the land base
Different logging practices, ie., selective vs. clearcut produces different results when near trails or over trails. Selective much less aggressive but we don't often know which type of logging is going to occur
Large clear cuts as the only harvest prescription - alternate forest practices not applied
Local overconcentration of harvest
No recognition of the value of the forest recreation experience
Tourism bureau - public pressure to "do more" to stop forestry in tourism areas. Not sure what else can do other than writing letters of support that seem to do nothing
